To date, I have served in both small and large mainstream schools, as well as in Integration Units and Special Schools. I have worked as a School Counselor in the 9th Special Education District based in Piraeus and in the 4th Special Education District based in Nea Smyrni, while also supporting the regions of Crete, Eastern Attica, and the Dodecanese. Subsequently, I held the position of Special Education and Inclusive Education Coordinator for the 4th PEKES (Athens-D district) and the 2nd PEKES (Athens-B district). Currently, I serve as an Educational Consultant in Special Education & Inclusive Education in Athens-D district.

For several years, I participated as a Special Education representative in the National Education Council, as well as in the proceedings of the National Dialogue on Education.
